## ALFATAPE 0.1.1

current version: 0.1.1

ALFATAPE is an emulation of a simple multi-track-recorder. It is built to work with KORG nanoKONTROL2 as a midi-controller. Of course you can use any other midi-controller, but you might have to fiddle around with the patch (yes, you have... but it's easily done - please refer to the README.txt).

As of version 0.1.1 you now also can use your computers keyboard to control ALFATAPE. There are two clickable buttons labeled "midi:on/off" and "keys:on/off". If you wish to control ALFATAPE with the computers keyboard, make sure "keys:on" is set.

You find the list of all the shortcuts (midi and keys) under "?" in ALFATAPE or via "help" (right-clicking).

You find the KORG-nktrl2 data file in the main-folder to flash your nanoKON-TROL. All it does is, it changes the track-controls (solo, mute, rec) to toggle-mode (instead of "momentary").

The goal of ALFATAPE is simple:

- no mouse-use
- no visualized audio
- fully destructive (like in the good old days)
- good transport-behavior
- easy to use

this is still an early alpha-release...
